I was very pleased to find Iraqi Marshlands Project named amongst the winners of this year's UN 21 Award Prize.

Working under difficult conditions, you have helped to demonstrate how environment is important to reconstruction efforts in a post conflict situation - and have done so in a manner that today makes us all proud.

Satellite images UNEP launched in 2001 brought to world attention the scale and pace of environmental degradation of the Fabled Marshlands of Mesopotamia and the plight of the Marsh Arabs. Since 2004, when you as a team started work in the Marshlands to restore the ecosystems and provide water to some 85,000 people, over 60% of the Marshlands have water again and up to 22,000 people have access to safe drinking water again.
